No. G.S.R. 23/P.A.4/1922/Ss. 17, 18 and 73/Amd. (3)/2007.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 73 read with sections 17 and 18 of the Punjab Town Improvement Act, 1922 (Punjab Act No. 4 of 1922) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules, further to amend the Punjab Improvement Trust Employees, Pension and General Provident Fund Rules, 1994, namely :—

**RULES**

1. These rules may be called the 'Punjab Improvement Trust Employees, Pension and General Provident Fund (First Amendment) Rules, 2007.

2. In the Punjab Improvement Trust Employees, Pension and General Provident Fund Rules, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 4, for sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“(2) The fund for the employees, who are members of the provincialised and non-provincialised services, shall be established by the Regional Deputy Director.”.

3. In the said rules, in rule 6, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“(1) The fund for the employees, who are members of the provincialised and non-provincialised services, shall be kept and administered by the Regional Deputy Director.”.

4. In the said rules, for Appendix 'A', the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely :—
