

It is Certified that c is duly complying the direction which are given under Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. As per the direction, the Municipal Council, Ahmedgarh has done the following works:

1. At Dumping Site, waste is being covered with the layer of soil on regular interval. The Plantation has already been done.
2. We do not burn any dry garbage.
3. The garbage vehicle is properly covered so that no garbage may scatter on road.
4. The fencing has been erected at solid waste dumping site.
5. Methyl dust has been spread and the liquid melathene has been sprayed over the dumping site. Herbal senatizer will also be spread on regular basis.
